



DREAM GARDENS-ARATOI



Thanks everyone for participating in this fun project. We look forward to seeing what progress you will make over summer. Reach out to Jo if you need help transferring the pattern from your image to fabric as a line drawing. Remember that the due date is July 2025!

 If you've been looking for a new stitch or technique to try Royal School of Needlework's Stitch Bank has approached the learning experience. It caters for visual and active learning styles.

Go to https://rsnstitchbank.org/, and select 'Stitch Wall'. When you have selected your stitch (can be anything from cheese board filling stitch to sword stitch), There is am'flip view' option that turns the image on a vertical axis. Mighty useful if you want to start at the end of a row....or if you happen to be left handed!

Illustrated drawings also explain the technique. If that does not quite work for you then a short video might be available.
